ASHES

The CC700 Fireplace Insert has a removable ash tray. The ashes should not be allowed to build up higher than the sides of the tray. If the coal shaker grate is installed, it is best to shake down the ashes every morning and evening. Shake the grate until live ashes start to fall. Do not shake unburned coals below the grate. It is also advisable to remove the ashes before shaking the grate in order to avoid handling hot coals. When removing the ash tray for ash removal, the insert doors should be open to prevent excessive draft in ash tray area.

CAUTION - KEEP ASH DOOR CLOSED DURING FIRING OF INSERT TO AVOID DEVELOPING EXCESSIVE TEMPERATURES.

DISPOSAL OF ASHES

Ashes should be placed in a metal container with a tight fitting lid. The closed container of ashes should be placed on a noncombustible floor or on the ground, well away from all combustible materials, pending final disposal. If the ashes are disposed of by burial in soil, or otherwise locally dispersed, they should be retained in the closed container until all cinders have thoroughly cooled.

FIRE SCREEN

The CC700 Fireplace Insert has been provided with a spark screen. This screen must be used if the insert is being operated with the doors open, to prevent hot sparks from popping out of the stove onto a flammable surface, such as a rug.

CAUTION!

The cabinet, cast iron doors, and other parts of the insert get very hot when the stove is in use. Fireproof gloves should be worn at all times when tending the fire, removing ashes or any other time direct contact with hot parts is possible.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. At the beginning of each heating season the fireplace insert and chimney should be inspected to see that it is in good working condition. The chimney should be cleaned of soot, creosote, and other residues.
- 2. The firebrick lining of your stove should be checked at least once a year. Should you discover any broken firebricks they should be replaced. New firebrick can be obtained from your COUNTRY COMFORT (TM) dealer.

Under the conditions of this warranty, the manufacturer of the COUNTRY COMFORT stove warrants that the stove is free from defects in material and workmanship for normal home use. The obligation under this warranty shall be limited to repair and/or replacement of any part or parts of the stove which prove defective under normal home use and service within five (5) years from the date of sale of the stove to the original purchaser and which shall be found defective by, the manufacturer or its authorized agent. This warranty is expressly in lieu of all other warranties expressed or implied, including warranties by statute, operation of law, or otherwise.

Manufacturer assumes no obligations or liabilities except as stated in this limited warranty which is provided for the purpose of stating the total obligations and liabilities under which manufacturer sells the stove and to provide the original purchaser with an express, extended limited warranty. No person is authorized to bind manufacturer to any obligation or liability and this warranty expresses the legal obligations of the manufacturer to the original purchaser. No obligation is assumed with respect to any other party.

This warranty does not apply to this stove or any part thereof which has been subject to accident, negligence, alterations, abuse or misuse even if used only for home applications. The manufacturer, Orrville Products, Inc., makes no warranty whatsoever in respect to accessories or parts not manufactured by Orrville Products, Inc., and which bear the name of the actual manufacturer. As to such items, the limited warranty of the accessory or part, to the extent allowed, is transferred from Orrville Products, Inc., to the original purchaser. Paint finish, and fire brick are expressly excluded from this warranty.

The original purchaser, as used in this warranty, shall be that person to whom the COUNTRY COMFORT stove is originally sold for home use.

This warranty shall be effective only if the original purchasers of the COUNTRY COMFORT stove is registered with Orrville Products, Inc., by sending this warranty form to Orrville Products, Inc., within thirty (30) days of the date of purchase or the date upon which the original purchaser takes possession of the stove, which ever comes first. Such registration or the failure to register shall not be deemed to create any obligation or liability by the manufacturer and this warranty with its conditions and limitations shall be the only procedure for obtaining any rights against the manufacturer and expresses the sole obligations and responsibilities of the manufacturer which are offered to the original purchaser and accepted upon purchase of the stove.

Any cause of action by the original purchaser against the manufacturer under this warranty can be only at the situs of Orrville Products, Inc., and the laws of the State of Ohio shall be applicable to this warranty.
